# **III.** Officer Reports

- A. President's Report
  - 1. Recent, Current, and Upcoming Events
    - a) BINGO (1/19/24)
      - (1) 20 tables have been requested from the high school in addition to the tables we already have at Caley. We have started figuring out a layout for bingo tables to prevent students from running around.
      - (2) Families will enter through the main doors. The queue line for purchasing/picking up bingo cards and dotters will run along the music room hallway.
      - (3) 31 families have pre-registered for Bingo night. We will request that homeroom teachers send an email out encouraging families to pre-register so that the night can run as smoothly as possible.

- (4) Food donations will be taken at the door.
- (5) We need to get a couple more prizes as well as food/drinks (pretzels, mixed chip bags, small water bottles).
- (6) Pizza orders are due by 1/17. The order for the pizza will be placed at Costco.

## b) Sock Concepts

- (1) The online portal has made this fundraising event simple. 62 pairs of socks have been sold.
- (2) Foot mannequins have been placed in PTC window case at school to show the different designs of socks.
- (3) Socks will be delivered to school with students' names and teachers.

## c) Art to Remember

(1) The company has received artwork. They will be shipping catalogs to school. We will make 33% profit off of each sale.

#### d) Book Fair

- (1) Book Fair dates will be February 26th March 1st. Setup day will be February 23rd.
- (2) We will be getting more book carts this fair. This is due to our large amount of sales at the fall book fair event. We will need to figure out a different layout on the stage for the book fair.
- (3) Should we pair the book fair with another event to bring families in to purchase books (ie community sport sign up night)?

#### e) Ice Skating

- (1) Event was very fun! It was less attended than years prior... Maybe this was due to it being 2 days after Christmas holiday this year?
- (2) We made a \$340 profit.
- f) Spring Fair (gift baskets)
  - (1) Balloon guy, Pertuccis, and Hedgehog Grill have been booked.
  - (2) We have started soliciting for gift baskets.
  - (3) We have an \$85 credit to Bean Bounce Rentals because the spin art was broken last year.
